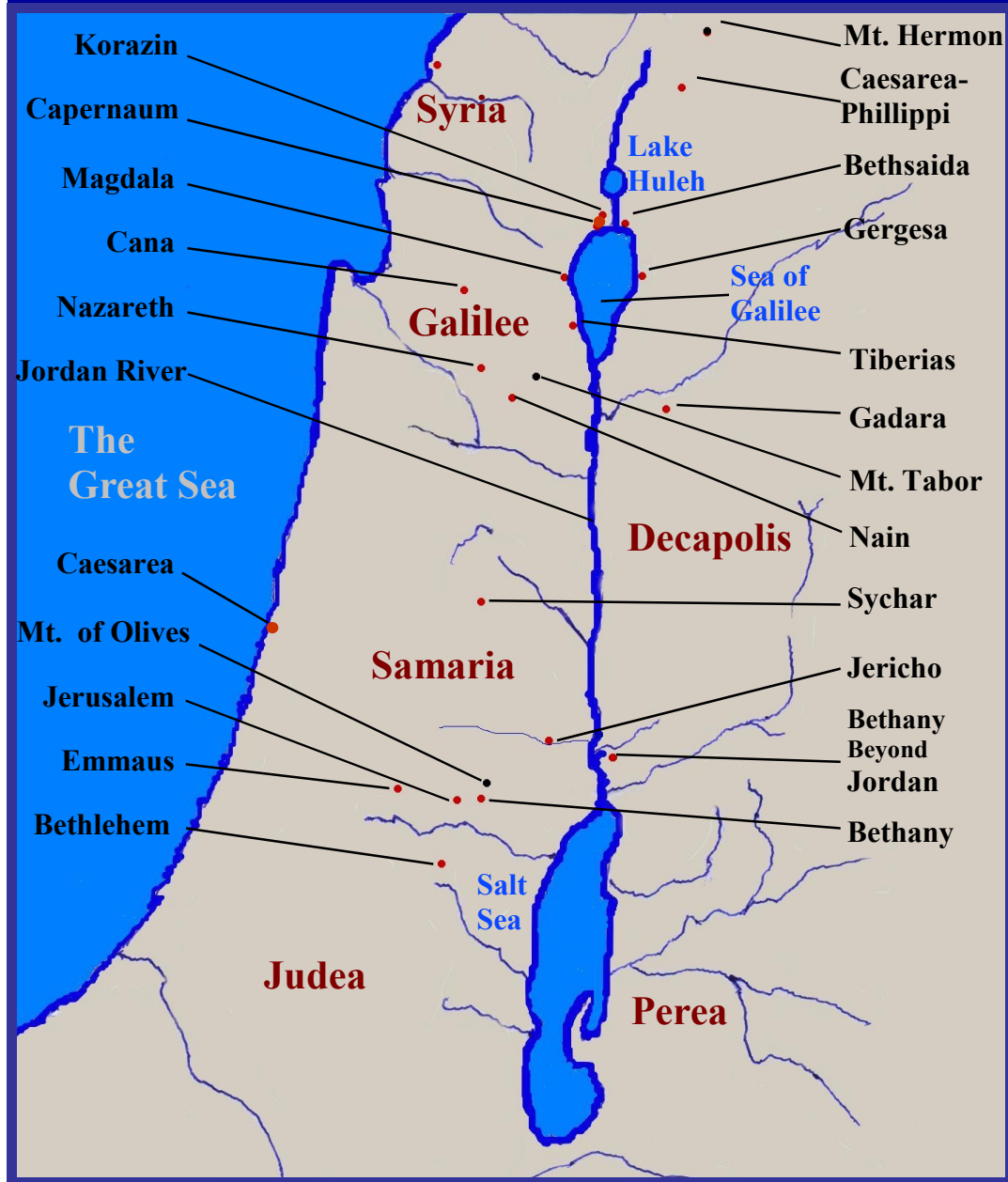


Mark 1:4-11

Jordan River



Heb. Yarden, "the descender;" Arab. Nahr-esh-Sheriah, "the watering-place" the chief river of Palestine. It flows from north to south down a deep valley in the centre of the country. The name descender is significant of the fact that there is along its whole course a descent to its banks; or it may simply denote the rapidity with which it "descends" to the Dead Sea. It originates in the snows of Mt. Hermon. The total length of the Jordan from Baniyas is about 104 miles in a straight line, during which it falls 2,380 feet. The first historical notice of the Jordan is in the account of the separation of Abraham and Lot (Gen. 13:10). "Lot beheld the plain of Jordan as the garden of the Lord." Jacob crossed and recrossed "this Jordan" (32:10). The Israelites passed over it as "on dry ground" (Josh. 3:17; Ps. 114:3). Twice afterwards its waters were miraculously divided at the same spot by Elijah and Elisha (2 Kings 2:8, 14). The Jordan is mentioned in the Old Testament about one hundred and eighty times, and in the New Testament fifteen times. The chief events in gospel history connected with it are (1) John the Baptist's ministry, when "there went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and were baptized of him in Jordan" (Matt. 3:6). (2.) Jesus also "was baptized of John in Jordan" (Mark 1:9).

Jesus' Baptism

There was a man whose clothes were made of camel's hair and animal skins, and for his food he ate wild honey and locusts. Do you know whom I'm talking about? No it's not Grizzly Adams. I'm talking about John the Baptist, and Jesus considered John the greatest of all Prophets.

John, the Bible says, was in the wilderness and he was preaching, that the people there needed to repent and be baptized, so that God would take away their sins. To repent means to turn around, to change from the sinful life one would lead, and walk in a new direction, and begin to do good with one's life according to the scriptures. Have you given your life to Jesus and followed in obedience to being baptized in water?

Many people came to be baptized of John in the Jordan River, from all of Judea and Jerusalem. Some asked John if He was the Messiah (God's chosen one to redeem fallen man), but he answered that there was someone yet to come whom he wasn't even worthy to unloosen his san-

dals. Do you know who John was talking about? John told the people that even though he had baptized them with water, yet the one to follow would baptize you with the Holy Spirit.

It happened that Jesus from Nazareth of Galilee had come to where John was baptizing in the Jordan. And as Jesus came to be baptized of John, John said I am not worthy to baptize you, but you should be baptizing me. Jesus answered that He must be baptized by John to fulfill the scriptures. God is so careful to perform every word of Holy Bible, because God can never lie, God is truth.

When John baptized Jesus, the Bible says,

“10 And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him: 11 And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.”

And Jesus got up and immediately walked off into the wilderness.
